# tmux Cheat Sheet

Sessions		
<b>tmux</b> Creates new tmux session	<b>tmux new -s [session_name]</b> Creates named tmux session	<b>tmux ls</b> Lists outs all sessions
<b>tmux kill-session -t [session_name]</b> Kills specified session	<b>exit</b>	Disconnects from tmux session
<b>tmux a</b> <b>tmux at</b> <b>tmux attach</b> Attach to last session (any of these commands will do the same thing)	<b>tmux a -t [session_name]</b> <b>tmux at -t [session_name]</b> <b>tmux attach -t [session_name]</b> Attach to the specified session (any of these commands will do the same thing)	

Keyboard Shortcuts	
Default prefix used with all tmux commands is <b>CTRL + B</b> . For specific commands, refer to the table below:	

Command	Action
List all shortcuts	<prefix> + ?
New window	<prefix> + C
Next window	<prefix> + N
List all windows	<prefix> + W
Rename a window	<prefix> + ,
Previous window	<prefix> + P
Find a window	<prefix> + F
Kill a window	<prefix> + &
Split panes vertically	<prefix> + %
Split panes horizontally	<prefix> + "
Toggle last active pane	<prefix> + ;

Command	Action
Swap panes	<prefix> + O
Kill pane	<prefix> + X
Break pane into a window	<prefix> + +
Restore pane from a window	<prefix> + -
Show pane numbers	<prefix> + Q
Toggle pane zoom	<prefix> + Z
Toggle between layouts	<prefix> + Spacebar
Move pane left	<prefix> + {
Move pane right	<prefix> + }
Switching between panes	<prefix> + Arrow keys
